- Is committed to attending the full Leadership Edmonton program (retreats, learning days, planning sessions).

Leadership Edmonton seeks to create a learning environment that reflects the diverse people and viewpoints that make up Edmonton. We welcome applications and inquiries from anyone who demonstrates leadership qualities and is dedicated to creating a new network of informed and committed community leaders. The selection committee chooses the class with a conscious effort to ensure that the group reflects a balance among the business, government and not-for-profit sectors.

The Leadership Edmonton program includes an opening retreat in October Learning Days November through June, and a closing retreat in June. The schedule for 2011 is attached. In addition to the scheduled class times, participants will have to prepare for each class. For example, participants will read 3-6 books during the program. Please be aware that preparation and full attendance throughout the program is essential. Even if your employer is not financially sponsoring your participation, it is important that you secure this time commitment to ensure that this course is a priority.

Throughout the year Leadership Edmonton will provide you with myriad opportunities such as workshops and lunch discussions, to enhance your understanding of our community, its strengths and challenges, and opportunities for leadership. Although these additional experiences are not essential, those who choose to take advantage will open doors to a vast network of leaders who make things happen in Edmonton and the Capital Region.

A personal interview will be required. An interview will be carried out by the Interview Team to review the participant's qualifications between August 15 and Sept. 10th.

The final decisions will be made by the Selection/Recruitment Committee based on the recommendations of the Interview Team, Leadership Edmonton Selection Committee, and the criteria set out for the program.

All candidates will be sent a letter of acceptance or of regret once the final decision has been made. Only candidates who have been selected will be contacted further. **Candidates will be notified regarding acceptance on Sept.10, 2010.**
